What is short term sub-acute care?

Short term sub-acute care is designed to help those people leaving the hospital, but are not able to manage independently in their homes. The goal is to allow some extra time to recover from an accident, surgery, a stroke or other disabling illness. This care incorporates

interventions by physicians, nurses, dietitians, social workers, therapeutic recreation specialists and other credentialed professionals who provide physical, occupational and/or speech therapy, wound care and IV therapy, etc.



Consider Lutheran Augustana Center

for intensive short-term restorative rehabilitation for the treatment of complex orthopedic, neurological and other medical conditions. Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy services are offered seven days a week and delivered up to three hours a day depending upon the patient's ability.



How would I learn about short-term sub-acute care?

Hospital discharge planning is a service to assist patients in arranging the care needed following a hospital stay. Discharge planners help arrange alternate care services including home care, nursing home care, rehabilitative care and other supportive services.

While in the hospital, the patient will be evaluated to determine medically necessary services as well as eligibility and authorization for insurance coverage.

Families are encouraged to participate in the discharge planning process and to visit nursing and rehabilitation facilities as part of the post-hospital care selection process. If the patient requires an alternate care setting for rehabilitation or nursing care, a choice of several appropriate facilities must be provided to the patient.

The recently renovated state-of-the-art rehabilitation gym provides a spacious, uniquely designed area equipped with the latest technology and equipment including:

- A WT-960 Tran-Sit Vehicle Driving/Transfer Simulator to strengthen transfer skills,
- MOTomed and NuStep to increase strength, flexibility and endurance,
- SARA Plus ensuring that existing mobility is used to the maximum,
- Body Weight Supported Ambulation device for gait and balance training,
- An Occupational Therapy Studio Apartment equipped with a training kitchen, bathroom and household furnishings,
- An outdoor rehabilitation garden with steps, a curb, rails and ramp.
